The Cordoba Provincial Council cooperates


The Cordoba Provincial Council cooperates with municipalities by providing financial aid as well as technical, economic, technological and legal assistance and consultancy to the local councils of the province.



ESPOBAN

Spain-Portugal Business Angels Network





The Espoban project (Spain-Portugal Business Angels Network) aimed to facilitate access to private investment for Spanish and Portuguese business projects.

The project pursued two objectives: to attract business initiatives in the development phase that required financing or smart capital and to create a pool of private investors that could participate in both Spanish and Portuguese projects.




Jacobean Routes in the Western Iberian Peninsula

This project aimed to revitalise the Mozarabic Way to Santiago on its almost 300-kilometre route through the province of Cordoba. Among other initiatives, the project involved:

- repairing damaged or deteriorated signs
- reconstructing river crossings and building rest areas
- furnishing pilgrim hostels
- promotional activities to engage local communities and businesses
- the creation of a cross-border network to invite local entities to join the network and offer their services
- actions to publicise the 14 stages and the other Jacobean routes of the Silver Way (Vía de Plata).

Enlaza: Córdoba, Municipios Inteligentes

Enlaza takes advantage of local councils' existing infrastructures to incorporate a smart open data and open government platform, bringing the administration closer to citizens and enabling real control over infrastructures.

Cordoba North and South Smart District (CITI)



The project aims to promote and broaden the smart city concept already being developed by the Cordoba Provincial Council through the **Enlaza**, **Cordoba Smart Municipalities project**, which has a single smart management platform that will also support this project.

More than 300,000 inhabitants of the province of Cordoba will benefit from the projects.

The Cordoba Smart District will include:

- 1. IoT sensorisation network
- 2. Smart Health
- 3. Smart Irrigation System
- 4. Environmental Monitoring Station (air quality, noise pollution, etc.)
- 5. Proximity System
- 6. Energy Management: Building Sensorisation
- 7. Video Analytics: Mobility, Security and Tourism

Singular Low-Carbon Economy Projects

The Cordoba Provincial Council, through its Delegation for Economic Assistance to Municipalities, has requested, secured and co-financed 134 projects for local entities in the province that seek to reduce carbon emissions and are committed to a green energy transition.

Specifically, the **152 public works** involve:

- Upgrading public street lighting with LED technology
- Rehabilitating the thermal envelope of municipal buildings
- Installing biomass heating systems and photovoltaic solar panels
- Plans for the implementation of sustainable urban mobility







Other Projects

These projects include professional skills training and financial support for young people aged 16–30 in situations of exclusion to start up a business and hire staff in rural areas.

The Cordoba Provincial Council is awaiting the resolutions of various calls for proposals under the **Spanish Government's Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan**.
